5.2 HOLIDAYS

The following shall be observed holidays for Marshall County non-union employees:

- New Year's Day
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday
- President's Day as observed nationally
- Memorial Day as observed nationally
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Veterans Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- The Friday following Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day
- Floating Holiday*

Any county employee whether full-time, part-time, or temporary, may be required to work on a holiday if the services of the employee are required for the performance of an essential public service. When a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed. When a holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed. Full-time personnel who are required to work on holidays shall be entitled to an additional day of vacation for each holiday worked, subject to the approval of the Department Head. When a part-time employee works on an observed holiday, they shall be paid at their regular rate.
