

Marshall County Conservation Board  
Regular Meeting June 12, 2023

President, Stave Armstrong, called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation to order on Monday, June 12, 2023 at the Grimes Farm and Conservation Center at 5:00 p.m. Board members present were, Tom Mack, Steve Armstrong, and Pam Paone. Board member Tom Deimerly was present by phone call. Staff present was Tami Krough, Emily Herring, and Jeremiah Manken. Board member Rich Naughton was absent.

There were no changes to the agenda.

No public comment.

There were no corrections to the minutes of May 8, 2023, they were declared approved as presented

On a motion by Mack seconded by Paone, the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Armstrong and Deimerly. Motion carried.

Herring asked the board to approve the FY2024 pay increases for staff. Herring stated the Marshall County Board of Supervisors approved a 9% increase. Mack moved to approve the pay increases for staff. Deimerly seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Armstrong and Deimerly. Motion carried.

Herring requested to change the July board meeting from July 10 to July 11 due to Project Aware. Deimerly moved to approve the date change of the July meeting to July 11, 2023. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Armstrong and Deimerly. Motion carried.

Herring requested approval to move to gravel to Three Bridges to repair the steps to the swinging bridge by Weidner Construction at a cost to not exceed \$6,000. Paone moved to approve the expense of moving gravel by Weidner Construction at a cost to not exceed \$6000. Deimerly seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Armstrong and Deimerly. Motion carried.

A discussion was held regarding the new Park Ranger/Maintenance position. Herring will reopen the job posting for a month.

End of the year meeting was not needed.

Non action items discussed: Green Castle Campground and Sand Lake addition

Mack moved to adjourn at 5:46 p.m. Deimerly seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Armstrong and Deimerly. Motion carried.
