Resolution-Construction Evaluation Resolution—(commonly known as the Master Matrix)

**RESOLUTION #2010-0008
CONSTRUCTION EVALUATION RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a “construction evaluation resolution” relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR’s decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2010 and January 31, 2011 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ADOPTION
OF A DISTRACTED DRIVERS STATUTE BY THE
IOWA LEGISLATURE**

WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has found that eighty percent of vehicle crashes involve driver inattention; and

WHEREAS, of the eighty percent of vehicle crashes involving driver inattention the largest single factor is cell phone associated use; and

WHEREAS, legislating to control behavior which results in inattention while driving would result a safer driving environment, save lives, and prevent injuries to people as well as damage to property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY MARSHALL COUNTY, IOWA, THAT:

Section 1. Marshall County, Iowa, requests that the Iowa Legislature adopt a statute which would prohibit driver behavior which results in inattention while driving and by doing so create a safer driving environment, save lives, and prevent injuries to people as well as damage to property.
