

**Marshall County Board of Supervisors
Public Meeting May 20, 2010, at 7:00 p.m.**

MINUTES

The Board held a public meeting on Thursday, May 20, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in Lions Park Community Building, Green Mountain, Iowa with all 3 members present.

Five affected residents of the proposed Lighting District were present along with three interested County residents. The discussion centered around three issues:

1. Green Mountain Street Light Project-

- a.) A review of the proposed boundaries of the proposed Lighting District. Additional parcels were added after a spirited discussion.
- b.) A consideration of whether additional signatures must be obtained, after expanding the District to include additional parcels. The signatures must meet the requirement of 25% of the affected property owners who also represent 25% of the assessed value of the real estate in the proposed Lighting District. The revised boundaries/map will be reviewed by County personnel and John Worden will be informed if additional signatures are necessary.
- c.) The individual benefits to residents and the amount of any levy to pay the costs associated with the Lighting District.

Contributors to the discussion of these issues included Betty Ulin, Russel L. Balmer, Steve Reis, John Worden and Jean Clawson.

A copy of the revised map and a statement of the conclusions concerning required signatures will be sent to the local residents listed on the attendance list.

- 2. Adjournment--**The next regular meeting is May 25, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. All business to be acted upon at that session should be submitted to the County Auditor's Office or the Board of Supervisors' Office by May 20, 2010, at 1:00 p.m. There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
