**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE GREEN
MOUNTAIN STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT
AND BOUNDARIES THEREOF**

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed signed by the required number of property owners owning the required total assessed valuation of property within the proposed street lighting district, all as required by Iowa Code Chapter 357C (2010);

WHEREAS, a public hearing, upon proper public notice, was held on the establishment of such a proposed district;

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Board of Supervisors is fully advised concerning the need to establish the boundaries of the proposed district, and the benefits thereof.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Marshall County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. This RESOLUTION establishes the Green Mountain Street Lighting District, with the boundaries as set out in the attached map. See Exhibit A attached hereto.

2. The Marshall County Board of Supervisors hereby appoints Paul Geilenfeldt, P.E., to do the preliminary plat required by Iowa Code Chapter 357C.5 (2010). Thereafter, a public hearing will be held on the preliminary plat. After this public hearing the Board of Supervisors shall approve or disapprove the preliminary plat, and may make such changes in the boundaries of the District as are deemed advisable.

This Resolution is adopted by the Marshall County Board of Supervisors on this 8th day of June, 2010, as a part of their regular Agenda, immediately following a public hearing as required by Iowa Code Chapter 357C.
