

**Marshall County Board of Supervisors
Public Meeting June 9, 2010, at 7:00 p.m.**

MINUTES

The Board held a public meeting on Wednesday, June 9, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in Lions Park Community Building, Green Mountain, Iowa with all 3 members present.

Fifty-three residents interested in the proposed sewer system were present along with the Board of Supervisors and John Kunc, Marshall County Public Environmental Health Officer. The discussion centered around the proposal by Central Iowa Water Association to build a sewer delivery system and lagoon in the Green Mountain area to serve local residents.

1. Green Mountain Sewer/ Lagoon Project in Cooperation with Central Iowa Water Association- The meeting began with a presentation by John Kunc concerning recently adopted statutes by the State of Iowa concerning septic tanks and related sewage disposal issues. After this presentation Kris Wildung from Central Iowa Water Association was to speak but never arrived to make a presentation.

The meeting was thrown open for questions and discussion. Questions centered around the scope and location of the system, location of the proposed lagoon, cost of hook-up at the time of construction and thereafter, the possible need for condemnation, monthly cost if participating in the system and related issues. It was made clear that the proposed project was not a project of Marshall County but of Central Iowa Water Association. Further progress on this proposed project will be the responsibility of Central Iowa Water Association. Marshall County will only respond to requests from Central Iowa Water Association and will do so after deliberation at a public meeting. It was also recommended that the affected residents of the Green Mountain area should think about selecting a representative(s) to coordinate their efforts with Central Iowa Water Association.

2. Adjournment--The next regular meeting is June 22, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., Courthouse, 3rd Floor, Meeting Room #2, Marshalltown, Iowa. All business to be acted upon at that session should be submitted to the County Auditor's Office or the Board of Supervisors' Office by June 17, 2010, at 1:00 p.m. There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
