Resolution No. 2010-0025

WHEREAS, Marshall County owns the following described real estate:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, except the South 95.0' thereof, and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter all being in Section 32, Township 82 North, Range 18 West of the 5th P.M., Marshall County, Iowa. The 118 acres is comprised of 74 tillable and 44 acres of pasture.

WHEREAS, Marshall County shall sell the real estate described above at public auction;

WHEREAS, the proceeds of sale would be exclusively used for capital improvements, including improvements on other farmland owned by Marshall County. These proceeds will not be used for general operating expenses nor placed in the general operating fund. These proceeds will be held and dedicated only for the purposes recited in this paragraph;

WHEREAS, the public auction will occur on November 23, 2010, at a time and place set in a public notice to be published by the Marshall County Supervisors.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Marshall County Board of Supervisors shall sell the above described real estate at public auction to be held on November 23, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., in Meeting Room #2, third floor, Courthouse, Marshalltown, Iowa. Sealed bids may be submitted prior to the beginning of the auction by those unable to attend the auction by depositing them in the office of the Marshall County Auditor before the time of sale. The person(s) bidding, or their designee, must be present at the auction in order to raise their bid. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids. A PUBLIC NOTICE of the sale shall be published which shall set out the place, date, time, and terms of sale.
