MINUTES

The Board was in regular session on Tuesday, December 7, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. in meeting room #2, 3rd Floor, northeast corner of the courthouse with 2 members present.

Supervisor Brooks was absent.

1. Approval or Amendment of Agenda—

Weed Commissioner--Public Hearing on Proposed Weed Assessment--Pursuant to Chapter 317.21 Code of Iowa; when the weed commissioner destroys any weeds under the authority of Section 317.16, after failure of the landowner responsible to destroy such weeds pursuant to the order of the Board of Supervisors, the cost of the destruction shall be assessed against the land and collected from the landowner. The total amount of \$1,884.43 will be assessed, and certified to the County Auditor and County Treasurer, and shall be placed upon the tax books, and collected, with interest after delinquent, in the same manner as other unpaid taxes. The tax shall be due on March 1 after assessment, and shall be delinquent from April 1 after due, including those instances when the last day of March is a Saturday or Sunday. When collected, the moneys shall be paid into the fund from which the costs were originally paid.
