**Local Match Resolution#2014-0027
for the
Hazard Mitigation Grant Program**

WHEREAS, Marshall County(hereinafter called "the Subgrantee"), County of Marshall, has made application through the Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division (HSEMD) to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for funding from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, in the amount of \$175,214 for the total project cost, and

WHEREAS, the Subgrantee recognizes the fact that this grant is based on a cost share basis with the federal share not exceeding 75%, the state share not exceeding 10% and the local share being a minimum of 15% of the total project cost. The minimum 15% local share can be either cash or in-kind match, and

THEREFORE, the Subgrantee agrees to provide and make available up to \$26,283.00 (twenty six thousand two hundred eighty three dollars) of local monies to be used to meet the minimum 15% match requirement for this mitigation grant application.
