11. Rose Festival Road Race - The Central Iowa Cycling Club would like to hold a bicycle time trial and Rose Festival Stage Race in the Bangor, Iowa area on June 21 and June 22, 2014. This bicycle race will take place on various Marshall County, IA roads.

Memorandum of Cooperation

The Central Iowa Cycling Club, an Ames, IA based bicycle racing club affiliated with USA Cycling, the governing body for bicycle racing in the United States, respectfully requests the use of Marshall County, IA roads E23, E18, S52, E29, and S62 to hold the Rose Festival Stage Race, a bicycle time trial and road race, on Saturday June 21 and Sunday June 22, 2014.

This event will be run under a USA Cycling permit which includes insurance coverage for participants and for Marshall County. It will be held under the supervision of USA Cycling licensed officials who will ensure a safe and fair event for all participants.

This event will promote the sport of bicycle racing in Iowa and showcase what rural Marshall County has to offer to cyclists from around the state and surrounding states. Bicycling promotes physical fitness and a healthy lifestyle.

The Marshall County Supervisors agree that this event offers positive benefits to the county and does not present an undue danger to participants and residents and, therefore, will cooperate with the Central Iowa Cycling Club in their use of the above named roads on June 21 and 22, 2014.

12. Lease between Masonic Holding Corporation and Central Iowa

Recovery/Marshall County—Discussion and action on a lease between the Masonic Holding Corporation and Central Iowa Recovery/Marshall County regarding room no. 200, located in the southwest corner of the second floor used for general office use for Central Iowa Recovery Program in the Masonic Temple Building, 26-30 South 1st Ave., Marshalltown. Terms of the lease shall be for 6 months. The term of the lease is April 26, 2014 – October 26, 2014, at a rate of \$225.00/month, for a total of \$1,350.00 for the six month lease.
