

**Marshall County Board of Supervisors Proceedings
Special Session March 31, 2015, 10:00a.m.**

MINUTES

The Board met in special session on Tuesday, March 31, 2015, at 10:00a.m., in meeting room #2, 3rd floor, northeast corner of the courthouse with all 3 members present.

1. Motion by Thompson, second by Patten, to approve the agenda as printed. All voted aye.
