Public Measure A

“SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?”

SUMMARY: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Marshalltown effective November 1, 2017.

“The use of the one percent (1%) local sales and service tax shall be changed in the City of Marshalltown effective November 1, 2017.

Proposed Uses of the Tax:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and service tax shall be allocated as follows:

78% for property tax relief

The specific purpose (or purposes) for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended is (are):

22% any lawful purpose

Current Uses of the Tax:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows:

75% for property tax relief

The specific purposes for which the revenues are otherwise expended are:

5% for any lawful purpose of the City of Marshalltown; and

20% for capital improvements, including storm sewer improvements and street repairs.”

60% required for passage of Public Measure A.
