Abatement of Real Estate and Mobile Home Taxes

Whereas, pursuant to Chapter 445.16, Code of Iowa, the County Treasurer has the authority to determine when it is impractical to pursue collection of property taxes through the tax sale or law suit remedies;

Whereas, upon making this determination the County Treasurer shall provide a recommendation of abatement to the Board of Supervisors, and the Board shall abate the following taxes:

513 Main St, Lot #23, Melbourne, Iowa, a mobile home described as a 1989 Maer. VIN # 61124, with delinquent taxes in the amount of \$84.00, including any penalty, interest and cost. This mobile home has moved out of Marshall County.

513 Main St, Lot #29, Melbourne, Iowa, a mobile home described as a 1972 Hilton. VIN # 442425772, with delinquent taxes in the amount of \$173.00, including any penalty, interest and cost. This mobile home has been junked and removed from the mobile home park.
