**3. Debris Removal in Marshall County, IA--Discussion and possible action to approve finding property in Marshall County, IA to place tree debris from the August 10, 2020 derecho wind storm causing widespread tree damage throughout the county.**

Motion by Thompson, second by Salasek to approve finding locations for tree debris to be completed by October 15, 2020 or earlier.

*Discussion: Paul Geilenfeldt said that the tree debris is so widespread and there is tree debris all over the county. The farmers have a location, but the acreages and unincorporated towns do not have a location. There are 3 options for debris I have identified:*

- *North of Garwin Road just west of Wallace*
- *Stanley Mill Road west of the River which is Conversation ground – may be able to get a permit from DNR to burn*
- *South of Marshalltown on 265<sup>th</sup>, just west of Highway 14 - we are getting a temporary easement; adding rock*

*Steve stated that Lamoille is able to dump on the west near the railroad tracks.*

*We need to state that it is only vegetative debris. Lucas said we should put up trail cameras at these 3 locations.*

*Paul said that we have contacted Thorp out of Jefferson who the City is using for the grinding. They said they can also grind for the County.*

*Discussion continued on details of the process and it was determined to be completed by 10/15/2020.*

*This will be FEMA qualified expenses.*

*Media release will be handled by Paul's Office.*

- 4. Secondary Road Dept.-Temporary Right of Entry Agreement** -Discussion and possible action to approve a Right of Entry Agreement between Marshall County, IA and Robert J. Coulter for the purpose of storing vegetative storm debris from the August 10, 2020 derecho wind storm. Marshall County and Marshall County residents will have the right to enter and exit this property to accomplish the above mentioned work. All storm debris shall be disposed of by Marshall County, IA under the direction of the County Engineer by March 1, 2021.

**The area is in Parcel ID 8318-27-400-006 with an address of 2558B 265<sup>th</sup> St. It is an area just West of 2558 265<sup>th</sup> St. and is South 370.00' along 2558 265<sup>th</sup> St. and 125' West of existing fence all the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 27, Township 83N, Range 18 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> PM, in the county of Marshall, State of Iowa.**

Motion by Thompson, second by Patten to approve Right of Entry Agreement between Marshall County, Iowa and Robert J. Coulter and authorize the Chairman to sign.
