MARSHALL COUNTY CASH CONTRIBUTION
RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0027**

Whereas the Region 6 Housing Trust Fund can annually apply for approximately \$259,092 of Iowa Finance Authority State Housing Trust Funds if the trust fund secures \$64,773 of local contributions, and

Whereas the per capita state share for Marshall County is \$111,021 if \$27,755 of local assistance is secured, and

Whereas the housing trust fund continues to seek applications for owner occupied housing improvements across the region which will be prioritized based upon housing needs, and

Whereas all the applicants must have annual incomes under 80% of the county median as determined by HUD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARSHALL COUNTY:

Section 1: Marshall County will provide \$27,755 of cash assistance in FY 2021/2022.

Discussion: Dave asked Marty Wymore for figures in 2019. Marty said in 2019 we spent \$184,000 plus special allocation of \$200,000 due to tornado in Marshall County. Dave asked about additional funds, Marty said he does not anticipate getting additional funding. Dave asked about numbers, Marty said we do not have issues getting applicants, we currently have 12 on the waiting list. Dave said we used to take these funds from Low and Moderate funds from the Harvester TIF, so these funds will need to come from General Basic. Steve asked for clarification. Marty said the other 3 counties have already provided their resolution. Discussion between Supervisors.

Jarret said we can add a sign for the drop box at the north door at Great Western Bank. Nan said she recommends going through September due to the high volume of traffic due to property tax statements. The Supervisors concurred.

Discussion: Lisa Gassman gave update on Census and a shout out to Cities that have improved. The question was asked whether they are going door-to-door yet. Lisa said yes it has begun and she experienced it first hand when they came to her son's apartment in Ames this past week.

17. Public Forum— Jon Thomas from State Center wanted to bring the radio project to the forefront. We had a situation where a 7 year old and 10 year old which were missing. It was himself and a deputy who could not communicate during the search. This ended up being a custodial issue and turned out fine. I see that this has been moved out to July 2021. Steve asked if this was due to Derecho, Jon said no, this was on August 8th.

Paul Geilenfeldt provided clarification on item #7 which was removed. He said that this will likely be on the 9/29/2020 Board Meeting.

Paul also wanted to say the 3 dumping sites are working out well. Dave said he has had calls about the County pick up debris. Paul clarified that if we picked up debris we cannot use DOT funds and only County funds. There is plenty of space for additional debris.

Kim Elder wanted to update on Derecho. There is State Public Assistance and the State Individual Assistance was approved. Kim provided the specifics of the Federal Individual Assistance and the information was turned in and completed this on Monday. She meets with the FEMA representative tomorrow. FEMA will determine if we meet the Federal Individual Assistance and hopefully know soon. Kim provided additional details of the data gathering in Marshall County.

Adjournment--The next regular session is September 15, 2020, at 9:05 a.m. All business to be acted upon at that session should be submitted to the County Auditor and Recorder's Office or the Board of Supervisors' Office by **Thursday, September 10, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.** There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:54 a.m.
