2. Marshall County sharing County Engineer with Jasper County, Iowa on a Temporary Basis - Discussion and possible action to approve Marshall County sharing their County Engineer with Jasper County on a temporary/ as needed basis for the purpose of signing documents.

Discussion: Paul has been talking with Brandon, Superintendent from Jasper County. Their engineer may be on medical leave for six weeks. This agreement is to end when the Jasper County Engineer returns. Paul added Section #8 to keep things simple. The Jasper County Annual Report had been submitted. An addition to Section #12 was to include a trip charge of \$35.00 from Marshall to Jasper County unless Jasper County brings documents to Marshall County. Section #6-Marshall County liability insurance should cover any possible errors and/or omissions. No bond should be necessary.

Debris areas where residents can drop off tree debris has been extended to October 31, 2020.

Motion by Thompson, second by Patten to approve the Marshall County Agreement sharing their County Engineer with Jasper County on a temporary basis. This agreement is on file in the Board of Supervisor's Office.
