Notice to the public--The Board of Supervisors welcomes comments from the public during the time allowed for discussion. You are requested to approach the microphone, state your name for the record and limit the time used to present your remarks in order that others may be given the opportunity to speak. The normal process on any agenda item is for the Chairperson to read the item from the agenda. The Board is given an opportunity to comment on the issue and/or place a motion on the floor. An opportunity for discussion may be presented at which time the public may participate and a roll call vote will follow.

The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met in regular session according to the posted notices in the Grand Courtroom, 1 E Main Street, and via online ZOOM on August 3, 2021. Chair Thompson called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m., and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Chair David E Thompson, Vice Chair Bill Patten, Member Steve Salasek. Salasek moved to approve the agenda as printed, second by Patten. Roll call vote, motion carried 3-0.

Patten moved to approve the **Consent Agenda** items, second by Salasek. Roll call vote, motion carried 3-0, items:

- a. **Approve Minutes.** Approve Regular Session Minutes of July 20, 2021, and Special Emergency Session Minutes of July 22, 2021;
- b. **Approve Claims.** Approve claims as audited and authorize the County Auditor and Recorder to issue payment of the same. The listing of claims paid at this meeting and all claims paid in the month of July will be published as part of the first meeting in August.

Motion by Patten, second by Salasek, to approve **Rental Agreement for Band Shell, August 26-30, 2021, “Marshalltown Resurrection Fest” for a live music festival at Riverview Park, August 27-28, 2021**. \$450 fee paid, insurance certificate on file, Marshall County noted as additional insured. Roll call vote, motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Salasek, second by Patten, to approve **the following list of project expenditures, to be paid from the AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUND.** Roll call vote, motion carried 3-0. These were recommendations received from the Marshall County ARPA Committee.

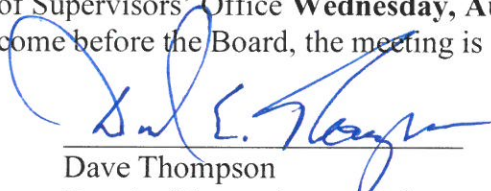
- a. Elections – 20 Freedom Vote – ADA Assisted totaling \$66,150. This project is for new hardware and technology for the voter assisted machines, tablets utilizing voice recognition software.
- b. Sheriff's Office – HVAC/Air Filtration estimate \$1,500,000. The current system is very dated.
- c. Sheriff's Office – Control Board estimate \$1,100,000. The highly integrated jail system includes cameras, jail locks and intercoms.

Motion by Patten, second by Salasek, to **approve selection of Breiholz Construction**, as either COURTHOUSE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER or GENERAL CONTRACTOR to take over for ONSITE for the Courthouse interior remodel project. The AIA Standard Contract to be negotiated will include performance bond and other conditions. Roll call vote, motion carried 3-0.

Tabled: RACOM Lease for Collins and Iowa Avenue Towers (until final draft available, likely July 2022) No action taken on tabled item, however, the board anticipates action at the August 17, 2021, meeting.
