MINUTES

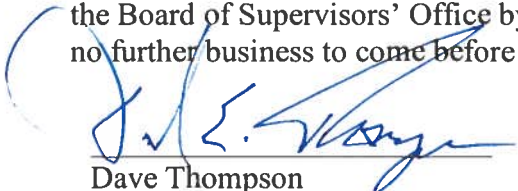
The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met in regular session according to the posted notices in the Marshall County Election Center, 107 S 1st Avenue, Marshalltown, Iowa, and online via ZOOM. Chair Thompson called the meeting to order on September 20, 2022, at 9:05 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Chair David E Thompson, Vice Chair Steve Salasek, Member Bill Patten. Patten moved to approve the agenda, second by Salasek. Motion carried 3-0.

Salasek moved to Certify the Election Canvass, the votes cast at the BCLUW School Special Election held on September 13, held at the Liscomb Community Building in Bangor/Liscomb/Taylor Precinct in Marshall County, State of Iowa, for Proposition IO and Proposition IP, second by Patten. Motion carried 3-0. Jessie Chizek reported there were 32 voters, including 1 absentee. Grundy County is the control county for this election.

Motion by Patten second by Salasek to Approve the Oktoberfest Band Shell Agreement, September 22 – 26, 2022, use of Annex Parking Lot and extension of use of courthouse grounds for 2022 Oktoberfest festivities. Motion carried 3-0.

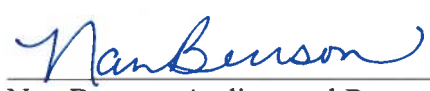
Public Forum: There were no public comments.

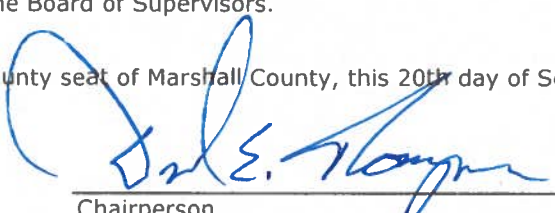

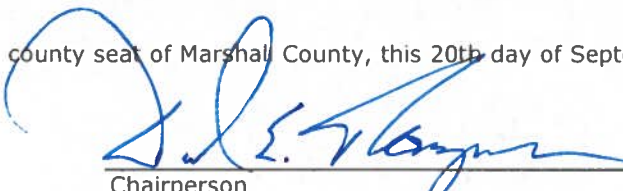

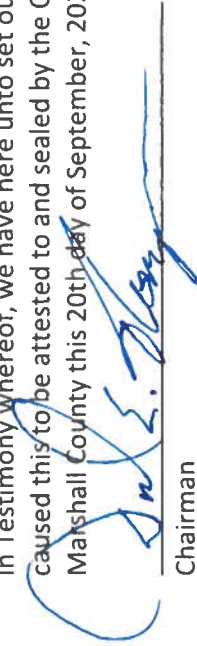
