MINUTES

The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met in regular session according to the posted notices in the Marshall County Sheriff's Office, 2369 Jessup Avenue, Marshalltown, Iowa, and online via ZOOM. Chair Thompson called the meeting to order on November 8, 2022, at 9:05 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Chair David E Thompson, Vice Chair Steve Salasek, Member Bill Patten. Salasek moved to amend and approve the amended agenda, tabling an item (Treasurer's Office, Status Change, Katie Sharer, from PT to FT, no change in wage rate, \$17.00 tabled to November 22, 2022) second by Patten. Motion Carried 3-0.

Patten moved to adopt the Consent Agenda, second by Salasek. Motion carried 3-0. Items:

1. Approve Regular Session Minutes, October 25, 2022.
2. Approve claims as audited and authorize the County Auditor and Recorder to issue payment of the same. The listing of claims paid at this meeting and all claims paid in the current month will be published as part of the first meeting of the following month.
3. Reappoint Tom Deimerly to the Marshall County Conservation Board, term expires 12/31/2027.
4. File Manure Management Plans:

Motion by Salasek, second by Patten to approve Status Change, Engineer Department, Travis Daters, change of position from MECH2 to MECH3, from \$27.88/hr., to \$28.40/hr., beginning on or after November 12, 2022. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Patten, second by Salasek, to approve New Hire, Sheriff Department, Jailer, Modestie Thongsouk, Permanent Full Time, \$20.41/hour, effective on or after 11-20-2022. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Salasek, second by Patten to approve two year contract extension with Teamsters Local #238 (Clerical Unit) and authorize Chair to sign. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Patten, second by Salasek to approve DNR WAIVER OF SEPARATION DISTANCE FOR CONFINEMENT BUILDINGS & MANURE STORAGE STRUCTURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH IOWA CODE SECTION 459.205 and authorize Chair to sign. This request by Marshall Ridge Farms, LLC, 1131-A 245th Street, State Center, IA meets the County Setback Requirement. Motion carried 3-0.

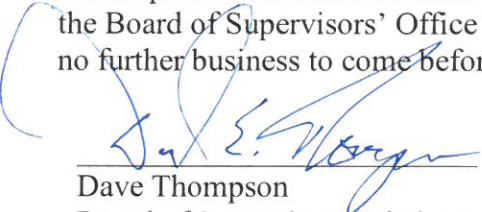
Motion by Salasek, second by Patten to approve Transfer #939, a onetime transfer of \$3,800,00.00 from General Basic Fund to Capital Projects for Courthouse final construction. Motion carried 3-0.

Patten moved to table the Decedent Transport bid discussion to the meeting of November 22, 2022, second by Salasek. Motion carried 3-0. The reason for the tabling is Dr Bethel was unable to attend the meeting due to an emergent conflict.

Public Forum: Benson encouraged individuals to vote and reminded the public of the November 15, 2022, Canvass meeting. The Rededication of the Courthouse is scheduled for November 19, 2022, Benson reviewed the program of events.

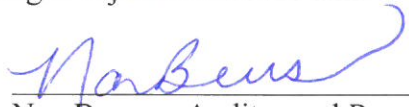
Mortician Anderson reviewed the prior arrangement for decedent transport.
