The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met in regular session according to the posted notices in the Courthouse, First Floor Meeting Room 1 East Main Street, Marshalltown, Iowa, and online via ZOOM. Chair Heil called the meeting to order on February 14, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chair Jarret Heil, Vice Chair Steve Salasek, Member Carol Hibbs. Salasek moved to approve the agenda second by Hibbs. Motion carried 3-0.

Hibbs moved to approve the Consent Agenda, second by Salasek. Motion carried 3-0. Items:

Motion by Salasek, second by Hibbs to modify Resolution 2024-0008 County Compensation Board Compensation Schedule for Elected Officials to 3.6% for County Attorney, County Auditor/Recorder and County Treasurer, 6% for County Sheriff and 3% for Board of Supervisors. Mark Eaton, a member of the Compensation Board representing the County Sheriff, spoke regarding the current status of the salaries and the work that has been done on the compensation board. Motion opposed 2-1 with Heil and Salasek opposing and Hibbs approving.

Motion by Salasek, second by Hibbs to approve Resolution 2024-0008 County Compensation Board Compensation Schedule for Elected Officials as presented by the Compensation Board except Board of Supervisors at 3%. Motion carried 3-0.
