MINUTES

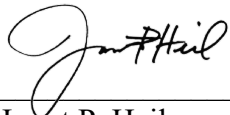
The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met in special session according to the posted notices in the Courthouse, First Floor Meeting Room 1 East Main Street, Marshalltown, Iowa, and online via ZOOM. Chair Heil called the meeting to order on December 24, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chair Jarret Heil, Vice Chair Steve Salasek, Member Carol Hibbs. Salasek moved to approve the agenda second by Hibbs. Motion carried 3-0.

Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Obligation of SLFRF Funds.

Motion by Salasek, second by Hibbs to approve a memorandum of understanding regarding obligation of SLFRF funds. This memorandum is obligating the remaining ARPA funds to the future Sheriff's Office and Jail renovation project. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Forum. Blaze Wurr, Marshall County Assessor, said the reappraisal for Marshall County may be happening earlier than expected, potentially in late 2025. Marshall County Auditor/Recorder Nan Benson stated that Marshall County offices are closed at noon on December 24th and all day on December 25th and 26th.
